Syros has various hotels and apartments in very nice locations next to the seaside (outside Hermoupolis in a range of 3 to 10 klm). Transportation is regular by the city's public buses (ticket cost, EUR 1,5 to 2,5) . You can share a studio for 2-4 people with kitchen, tv, air-condition, with starting prices from 20-25 Euros per person.

If anybody decides to stay on his own expense, then the amount of 250 Euros will be detracted from the total fee.

Scholarships

Scholarships to help cover tuition fees and travel expenses will be allocated once participants have been accepted although these are offered in the cases of real financial need. We are extremely grateful to numerous foundations, companies and individuals for offering scholarships to the Cyclades Festival Academy.

The age limit for is 30 years old (as at 1 July 2010)

Application

Your application for must contain the following:

- Application form completed and signed
- Copy of birth certificate or similar official document (ie passport) which proves your date and place of birth
- Detailed curriculum vitae (resumé)
- Statement of purpose in English (one page maximum) explaining why you wish to participate in the Cyclades Festival Summer Academy and what you hope to achieve from it
- An indication of all chamber music you have played and at what level
- A letter of recommendation from a musician of acknowledged international standing
- Two identical LIVE high-quality CD recordings with three contrasting pieces of music. DVDs are welcomed but should be sent in addition to, but not instead of, CD recordings. This recording should include a movement from a concerto, a solo work and an accompanied work.
- One Digital publicity photograph which can be included on an additional CD-R in your application package.
- Proof of payment of the application fee (see below).

Fee for application

All prospective participants are required to pay a non-refundable application fee of Euros 100.

Tuition fee 2010.

For accepted participants, the tuition fee (**Category A**) in VIOLIN, VIOLA, CELLO, DOUBLE BASE, FLUTE, CLARINET, BASSOON and FRENCH HORN is EUR 600 (approximately US\$800)

For **category B** the tuition fee is EUR 400 (approximately US\$ 530)

However, in cases of genuine financial need, and after being accepted to the Cyclades Festival Summer Academy, participants can apply to receive a scholarship in order to take part.
